- Engage Universities and Colleges with local and general elections getting more students onto the electoral roll, meaning their voice can be heard in 2015!

I want to see an engaged membership, where we have every union sending at least one delegate to National Conference.

On Block I will

- Support the continued campaign for fair gender representation, in line with the work of the Women’s campaign.
- Lobby NUS to engage in wider-scoping membership events. Offer subsidies to members as a way to remove barriers to participation.
- Mobilise students’ unions members nationally to vote in their own elections and with the 2015 general election ahead ask NUS to invest in the 56% of young people who can, but don’t, vote.
