I'm a student at Sheffield College, a socialist, feminist and labour movement activist. I work in the Department of Work and Pensions, where I'm Chair of my PCS union branch and have been involved in many strikes, disputes and struggles. I'm a member of the National Campaign Against Fees and Cuts and Workers' Liberty.  
NUS needs to reach out to the people I study, work and organise alongside – working-class people at the sharp end of exploitation and the government's attacks – and help us organise. That means a mobilising, fighting national union, not the multi-million pound waffle-spewing machine we have now.

## **CAMPAIGNING IN FE**

Last year conference passed a radical new FE policy proposed by the NCAFC. Unfortunately the leadership decided to ignore it! I stand for a fight to end all fees in FE, restore a grant/maintenance allowance (this time at a decent level) and build campaigning links with FE workers. I will push to organise a national activist conference open to all FE and school students to help build functioning, campaigning unions and/or activist groups in schools and colleges. Migrant workers studying ESOL and adults studying part time whilst working or unemployed must also be a priority.

## **TURN THE NUS AROUND**

I stand for a serious fight against cuts, and for Free Education and living grants for all. Last year's national demo was an embarrassment – we need a properly built first term demo and a year-long campaign of protests and direct action. And we need to mobilise students on other issues like housing and the NHS. We should be supporting every strike, mobilising our members on picket lines and organising students at work. Instead of waiting for a Miliband government to save us, we need to fight every attack now, and link up with the unions and Labour left to change Labour Party policies. I will campaign to tax the rich and expropriate the banks – our goal should be a workers' government that serves the majority as Cameron and Clegg serve the rich.

## **FOR A SOCIALIST FEMINIST MOVEMENT, GET SERIOUS ABOUT LIBERATION**

I will fight for women's liberation – from fighting to extend abortion rights and sex education to defending crèches and other provision on campus. We need to put the Left's house in order too – from "socialists" supporting reactionary, anti-women movements in the Middle East by claiming they are "anti-imperialist" to the farce over Julian Assange and rape apology. I will stand with transgendered sisters and brothers under attack. I will fight for migrants' rights. I will launch a national campaign against the bigoted antics of privileged "lads" and right-wingers – from racist and sexist "banter" to the likes of "natives and colonials" parties and "blacking up".

## **INTERNATIONAL SOLIDARITY**

From the continuing crisis in Greece to resistance to right-wing, theocratic counter-revolution in Tunisia and Egypt, workers and the oppressed are fighting back. International solidarity and links could not be more important.
